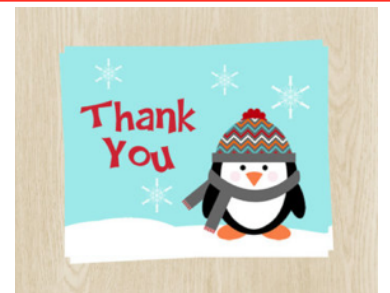


AFTER SCHOOL @ PR
